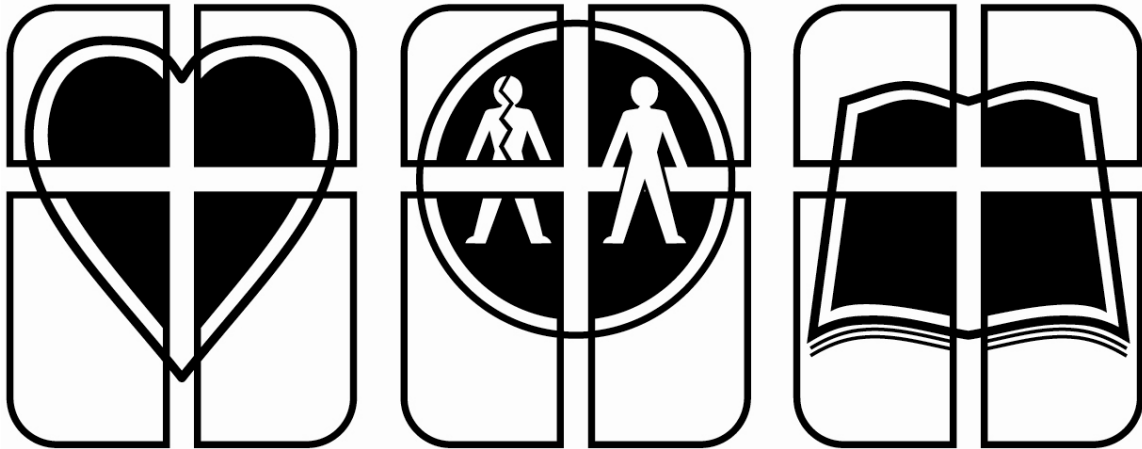


Stephen Ministry WORKSHOP
